

## **Bogdan Wojtyniak, Sc.D.**

is an Associate Professor and Deputy Director at the National Institute of Public Health-National Institute of Hygiene (NIPH-NIH), the Head of Department-Centre of Population Health Monitoring and Analysis. The area of his activity includes assessment of the Polish population health status and its social, behavioural and environmental determinants. He has been short term employee and Advisor to the WHO in the field of environmental health, health information, monitoring and evaluation of health trends.



He was PI, consultant and co-investigator in a number of projects funded by the EU, World Bank and WHO. He was one of PIs of the project on epidemiology of mental disorders - EZOP Poland, PI of the Project: "Atlas of mortality of the Polish population". He participated in the development of the Polish National Health Programmes and monitoring their health effects.

He is a member of Eurostat Expert Group for morbidity data in EU countries, a member of Technical Group that prepared new standard population for Europe and a member of the EU Expert Group on Health Information. He is a member of the Sanitary-Epidemiological Council of the Chief Sanitary Inspector and a member of the National Council for the Oncology.
