



**Professor Danuta Koradecka**

has devoted her entire professional life to scientific work in the Central Institute of Labour Protection – National Research Institute, starting from the position of assistant up to the title of professor of medical sciences awarded in 1989.

A scientific activity of Professor Koradecka is centered on shaping working conditions that meet necessary requirements for workers' life and health in various sectors of economy.

It includes:

- implementation of a modern system for maximum admissible concentrations and intensities for agents harmful to health in the working environment
- standardised requirements for work safety and ergonomics
- methodology and workstations for testing psychophysical capabilities of a human body under various workload and environmental factors
- guidelines for medical, organisational and technical prevention in the working environment

The findings of the programmes provided the basis for the position of the Polish government presented to the European Commission before the accession. Professor Koradecka's lifetime achievements include 248 publications.

She participates in the activity of Polish and foreign publishing committees of scientific journals (13). Prof. Koradecka holds a number of functions, e.g. in the Labour Protection Council, Scientific Committees of the Polish Academy of Sciences, the General Council of Research Institutes.
